Unit 7: Telling the time

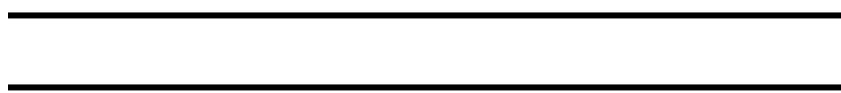
This unit is about telling the time in Chinese.
